

FY 2002 Project Update

- 1) 1) LaCenter Bottoms (WA-56-2)- 400 acres of drained wetlands and a channelized creek along the East Fork of the Lewis River, near LaCenter, WA. Restoration involves restoring the connectivity of the creek with 6 large wetland complexes by installing 3 fish friendly water control structures and revegetation. Restoration 2003/4.
- 2) Marietta Slough (WA-44-52)- 600 acres of diked wetlands along the Nooksack River, near Bellingham, WA. Restoration will involve dike breaching, ditch filling, building a setback levee, and replanting. Restoration 2003.
- 3) Remlinger WRP (WA-44-49)- 280 acres of diked pasture along French Creek, draining into the Snohomish River, near Everett, WA. Restoration will involve shallow excavation, creation of low berms, installation of water control structures and tree planting. Restoration complete in 2002.
- 4) Smartweed WRP (WA-46-1)- 110 acres of diked pasture along French Creek, draining into the Snohomish River, near Everett, WA. Restoration will involve shallow excavation, creation of low berms, installation of water control structures and tree planting. Restoration completed, 2002.
